## Jesus Healed the Official's Son

**John 4:46-54**

After Jesus returned to Cana, the town where He had done His first miracle, a royal official heard that Jesus was in town. The official's son was very sick, so the official traveled several miles from Capernaum to Cana.

When he found Jesus, he pleaded with Him: "Come and heal my son! He is about to die!"

Jesus said, "Unless you see signs and wonders, you will not believe in Me."
